#### The Sport Diver Summer Internship

Based in Winter Park, Florida, the recipient of this internship will gain in support of the publishing cycle of Sport Diver magazine. This is an opportunity to get real world experience in magazine publishing, including all facets of taking the product from start to finish.

Length of Internship: A six-week publishing cycle during the period June 9 - July 22, 2012

#### Eligibility Criteria:

## Budget

A grant of \$1,000 will help to cover travel to/from site and related living expenses. Housing may be provided by a member of the Sport Diver staff, depending upon the needs of the intern. The intern will be given a monthly stipend to cover these incurred costs. All expenses must be approved expenses or have the written approval of the Internship Coordinator. Any expenses that are unapproved or are above the grant amount will be the responsibility of the intern.

## Written Report

Upon completion of the Internship, the recipient will be required to complete a written review of his or her experience.
